



... by training your attention





The state of your attention determines the quality of the questions you ask

- and the quality of the other person's response
- and thereby, the quality of the interactions between people.




Clean Language questions protect the *other person* from your contempt, prejudice and fragility.

And they protect *you* from believing everything you think.



Belonging

Paying high quality attention to the words the other person says, accepting them and their experience says, 'You matter to me.'



Freedom

The other person can answer in a way that suits their system – not yours – which creates freedom for them to be themselves.

From micro to macro changes

Clean Questions, by themselves, are micro-interactions that change the quality of attention to increase safety and belonging and freedom of thought.

Increasing the number of these micro-interactions then leads to macro shifts in attention and attitude.

These shifts foster the conditions that support Agile mindsets and Agile transformations.


